# I. THE PARTIES

- 1. Plaintiff, NextAlarm Monitoring Services, Inc. ("NextAlarm"), is a corporation having its principal place of business at 408 Bryant Circle, Ojai, California.
- 2. Defendant, Uplink Security LLC ("Uplink Security"), is a corporation having its principal place of business at 1600 Parkwood Circle, Suite 500, Atlanta, Georgia.

# II. JURISIDCTION AND VENUE

- 3. This Court has subject matter jurisdiction pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1331 (federal question), §1332 (a) (diversity of citizenship), and §1338(a) (question related to patents).
- 4. Venue is proper in this judicial district pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1391 and §1400.

# III. FACTS GIVING RISE TO PATENT INFRINGEMENT

- 5. NextAlarm sells residential and commercial alarm systems throughout the United States.
- 6. NextAlarm sells monitoring services which monitor alarm systems throughout the United States.
- 7. A conventional residential or commercial alarm system transmits its signals to a monitoring service over the telephone lines.
- 8. NextAlarm is the owner of U.S. Patent No. 7,593,512 ("the '512 Patent") and U.S. Patent No. 7,734,020 ("the '020 Patent") which cover an alarm monitoring system that transmits its signals to a monitoring service over the Internet and which previously transmitted its signals to the monitoring service over telephone lines.
- 9. NextAlarm sells its Alarm BroadBand Adapter, and related products which it marks with the '512 and '020 Patent numbers in accordance with 35 U.S.C § 287.

- 10. NextAlarm's Alarm BroadBand Adapter converts the alarm signals into a voice over internet protocol (VOIP) and transmits the alarm signals to a monitoring service over the Internet.
- 11. Uplink Security offers for sale and sells its 5100 Universal Broadband Alarm Communicator and related products in this district, which is an alarm monitoring system that transmits its signals to a monitoring service over the Internet.
- 12. Uplink Security's 5100 Universal Broadband Alarm Communicator infringes the '512 Patent and '020 Patent under 35 U.S.C. § 271.

WHEREFORE, NextAlarm prays that a judgment be entered in its favor and against Uplink Security as follows:

- (a) Uplink Security infringes U.S. Patent 7,593,512 under 35 U.S.C. §271;
- (b) Uplink Security infringes U.S. Patent 7,734,020 under 35 U.S.C. §271;
- (c) Uplink Security be enjoined from further infringing U.S. Patent No. 7,593,512 and U.S. Patent No. 7,734,020;
- (d) NextAlarm be awarded damages pursuant to 35 U.S.C. §284;
- (e) NextAlarm be awarded prejudgment interest;
- (f) NextAlarm be awarded its attorney fees pursuant to 35 U.S.C. §285; and
- (g) any further and just relief the Court deems equitable and appropriate.
